# **Subjects:**

- 3. The third activity presenting Intellectual Output 8. The participants were informed about the four products developed by the partners.
- 4. After lunch, Intellectual Output 9 was presented to the participants by showing them the materials developed by the partners.
- 5. After the presentation of the Intellectual Outputs developed in the period after the first multiplier event, a recapitulation of the developments related to Intellectual Outputs 1, 4 and 5 was done. An important reason for this was to introduce to participants that had not attended the first multiplier event the first project outputs, and at the same time give update to those who attended the first multiplier.
- 6. As a next activity, a discussion on the practical possibilities to use the newly developed Intellectual Outputs was facilitated. IGA presented its new project aiming to bring theater and in particular educational theater to disadvantaged young people in Plovdiv.
- 7. The event ended with feedback from participants and closing words by IGA's Unlocked project staff members.
